



A FEW FACTS ABOUT THE ICE/ENDO 2014 MEETING

- ICE/ENDO 2014 recorded more registrants than any other annual meeting in the Endocrine Society's nearly 100-year history.
- More than 10,000 registrants representing 96 countries traveled to Chicago
- Over 3,200 abstracts were presented
